EXTRACT TO THE EDITOR - DATED
Augusta, (Ky) Feb. 7th 1812

"GENTLEMEN - This morning we have experienced a very severe shock of an earthquake, at 20 minutes past three o'clock: The vibrations continued three minutes, and appeared to come from the north-west: they came in quick succession, so that we perceptibly felt three perpendicular shocks more severe than the other vibrations - these were much more severe than those of the 16th Dec. or the 23d ultimo."
