Circleville, Ohio, February 12

Several very severe shocks of earthquake have been felt in this place since our last. That felt on Friday morning, at forty-five minutes past three o'clock, was, we believe, much more terrible than any of those which preceded or followed it. It was preceded by a rumbling noise like distant thunder; and the shaking continued, with more or less violence for about three minutes.
