Earthquakes

Between the hours of 3 and 4 on the morning of Friday last, a shock of the earthquake was felt in this place, much more alarming and violent than any which have hitherto been experienced. It was also of greater duration, and accompanied with rumbling noise and flashes of light from the N. West. The bricks on the houses, were in some places, removed from their positions. The buildings were violently agitated, and the walls are known in some instances, to have been cracked.
