The Earthquake noticed in our last, says the Augusta (Georgia) Herald, was felt in every direction from this place as far as we have yet heard from. In Columbia, South Carolina, several successive shocks were felt in this place, and at about the same hours. In Milledgeville, the state House was shaken as to cause the clapper of the Bell in the Cupula repeatedly to strike. - In Savannah the shock was equally severe, as it was in different places in the up country.
