Richmond, February 8. Another earthquake was felt in this city yesterday morning (the 7th) about 5 minutes before 4 o'clock. The undulation was more powerful than any we have felt before. People were awakened; bed-steads rocked; pendulous bodies vibrated and everything was felt to tremble. The shock was felt for 1 or 2 minutes and there could have been two or more shocks. There appeared a rumbling noise like the motion of a wagon over pavement. A chimney was tumbled onto the roof of a house.
