Washington, KY: Jan. 25

A considerable shock of an Earthquake was felt at this place on Thursday morning last about 15 minutes past 9 o'clock. It commenced with a jarr or vibration of the earth, and lasted about a minute, and terminated in a rumbling noise, similar to distant thunder. We are informed that it was also felt in Maysville at the same time and continued much longer, and in a short time was succeeded by two others the same day.
